"HeritAccess: access to culture and heritage in rural surroundings through the interactive digital experience"

PROJECT No 2022-1-ES01-KA220-ADU-000086106



















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#### INTRODUCTION

HeritAccess Database is the result of the work of 6 organizations from 5 countries who investigated during almost 1 year the accessibility features of the rural and wine heritage sites in their closest surroundings, in the frame of Erasmus+ Cooperation Partnership, in field of adult education.

With the objective of selecting and describing of at least 15 rural sites per project country (Greece, Italy, Serbia, Slovenia, Spain) during "WP2 – A2 Identification of the target groups' needs" project phase, the HeritAccess partnership surveyed more than 100 heritage managers, owners, staff members and responsible personnel of rural sites, inquiring the status of the place they work, organize and promote for their visitors.

The criteria to select each location and register it for the present database have been:

- Historical, artistic, architectural value of the site (including age of the site whenever applicable);
- Access for disabled people, including possible difficulties and barriers;
- Geographical closeness to the area of the project partners involved, for immediate impact.

Therefore, the present output presents 75 described rural and wine tourism-related sites that will be advised for improvements based in the future created project outputs, especially the HeritAccess Guide.

The result – input of WP2 – A3 - represents in a way the roadmap towards the progress made / to be made on accessibility in wine tourism field of these countries, and by extension, in Europe, in order to enhance the knowledge of wine culture and rural heritage among all adults, despite their abilities and conditions.

Out of these 75 sites, 5 (one per country) have been selected to be made accessible through 360° panorama, and then disseminated as HeritAccess Digital Experience: <a href="https://heritaccess.novopano.de/">https://heritaccess.novopano.de/</a>.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	Liakou Winery
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	24th km Kalambaka-Deskatis, Regional Unit of Trikala.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	In 2006 the cultivation of vines began and in 2009, the privately owned winery was created.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	There is a value associated with the place. Near the rural site rises one of the most impressive and imposing geological phenomena, the rocks of Meteora, which are considered one of the most important monuments in the world. There, from the 10th century, the monasteries of Meteora were built, which are important centres for the preservation of manuscripts and have played a decisive role in the preservation of our tradition and culture. The monks made sure to preserve and transmit the art of viticulture and winemaking.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Blind/or people with reduced visibility can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site. Ground floor elevated with stairs.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	The rock of Meteora, Trikala.

HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	There is a historical cultural approach, starting from ancient Perravia, until today, the mythology and the particular naturalistic value of Mount Olympus, the arched bridges, and the monasteries, the folk and musical tradition.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	- The visitable winery has no stairs to access the main visit area.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	Castle of Velika
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	Northern edge of the beach of Velika in the Regional Unit of Larissa. Nearest to the city of Larissa.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	It is a fortification of the early Christian years (6th century), located on the hill east of the Monastery of Theologos in Melivia, a short distance from the sea. It was built on the site of the Acropolis of ancient Melivia, the city of the Homeric king Philoctetes, which was destroyed by the Romans in 168 BC.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	The Castle of Velika is a fortified settlement at a short distance from the sea. It is built on the ruins of an ancient fortification. The settlement extended outside the fortification. Excavations have revealed part of the fortification with square towers and gates, a three-aisled basilica, large storage buildings, buildings associated with military uses and the house of a prominent person of the settlement.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory impaired people have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site. After the maintenance and restoration works of the castle, there is new access to the east side for safer visits, and extensive cleaning of the east and south sides of the castle was carried out. The walls were reinforced by filling in the stones that had been detached on most of the outer side and limited restoration work was carried out on the damaged sections. On the outer side of the castle, there is a paved walkway with steps for the convenience of visitors, stone seats and information signs.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	The main tourist attraction is the natural beauty, the picturesque villages and the beaches of the area.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	Ancient and Byzantine acropolis of Farsala
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	On the hill Prophet Elias, south of the city of Farsala.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	It was formed during the Late Archaic period, more specifically at the end of the 6th century BC.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	The acropolis has an elongated shape. There are four main phases of fortification of the area. The first dates from the end of the 6th/beginning of the 5th century BC, the second from the second half of the 4th century BC, the third from the Early Christian period and the last from the Middle Byzantine period. The ancient remains are preserved in better condition.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory impaired people have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site. The hill consists of two plateaus, eastern and western, with a narrow gap between them. There is access to the eastern plateau, and work is underway to provide access to the eastern and western plateaus.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	Monuments and archaeological sites, traditional settlements and picturesque villages.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	Milea Winery
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	Argalasti, South Pelion, near to city of Volos.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	The Winery dates back to the late 2000s.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	Auditory impaired person, person in a wheelchair can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site. The vineyard was chosen to be planted with Chardonnay and Merlot varieties after studying the microclimate of the area. The winery is equipped with modern winemaking equipment and areas for the production, ageing, bottling and storage of the wines. The sloping soils of the area, good water drainage and the particular climatic conditions of the area contribute decisively to the special character of the wines produced by the winery.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	The vineyard occupies an area of about 30 acres and is located at an altitude of 300 meters.  The area of both the winery and the vineyards is open to visitors.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	The area is attractive for its coastal settlements, Mount Pelion and villages, tourist resorts and nature tourism.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	Archaeological site of the Neolithic settlement of Sesklo
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	It is located on the Kastraki hill, in the area of Sesklo, near to the city of Volos.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	The settlement was inhabited from the middle of the 7th millennium until the Middle Bronze Age.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	The settlement was inhabited from the middle of the 7th millennium until the Middle Bronze Age and reached its peak in the Middle Neolithic period. The settlement is one of the oldest discovered in Europe.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory impaired people can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site.  There is a cobbled path leading to the settlement.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	In the area of Sesklo, the Neolithic settlement is a tourist attraction, with numerous visits by both school groups and tourists.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	Agricultural Wine Cooperative of Nea Anchialos "Dimitra"
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	It is located on 4th km of the National Road of Nea Anchialos – Mikrothives, near N. Anchialos and the city of Volos.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	The Cooperative was founded in 1918 and since then it has been active in many areas of processing and marketing of agricultural products.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	In 1908 the refugees from Eastern Rumelia settled in Nea Anchialos, bringing with them the knowledge of viticulture. The Cooperative was founded by them in 1918 and since then it has been active in many areas of processing and marketing of agricultural products.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory impaired and people in a wheelchair can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	Picturesque coastal settlements, tourist facilities and resorts.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	FARM TZANAKOULIS
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	Located on the heights of Mesorrachi of Larissa.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	The history of the farm begins in 2006 when the Tzanakouli family started to establish organic vineyards with wine-making varieties in their privately owned fields.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	The stone-built winery, traditional but modern, is built in the vineyards and bears the name EFYRA, because in this location until the 6th century BC the ancient Greek city of Ephyra, which Homer mentions in the Iliad, flourished. The estate with a long tradition in French varieties and the famous Greek ones has also started growing fig, plum and pomegranate trees for the production of traditional jam, while in recent years a vineyard with table grapes has been cultivated.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory impaired and people in a wheelchair can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	Mount Olympus, winter tourism, archaeological sites.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	Tsilili - Theopetra Estate
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	Lies at east of Meteora, on semi-mountainous slopes, around the prehistoric cave of Theopetra and it is located in the wider region of city of Trikala.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	In 1996, the Tsilili family proceeded to create a model vineyard with the aim to revive the vineyard of Meteora.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	The Tsilili family created a model winery, with the aim of promoting the specificity of the region and the revival of rare Greek varieties. The long-standing historical tradition and modern technology are united with human inspiration and highlight the wine culture of the place, which is linked to the vineyards of Meteora.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory impaired and people in a wheelchair can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	The rural site has notable nearby destinations, such as mountain villages of Aspropotamos, the ski resort of Pertouli, Lake Plastiras, Metsovo and Grevena.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	Archaeological site of the Neolithic settlement of Dimini
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	It is located 5km from the city of Volos, in the village of Dimini.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	It was inhabited from the end of the 5th millennium until the end of the Bronze Age.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	The Neolithic settlement of Dimini is located on a low hill. Southeast of the hill is the important Mycenaean settlement of Dimini, which in the 14th and 13th centuries BC was organized and reached its greatest peak, while in the 12th century BC it was destroyed and abandoned by the inhabitants and the site was re-inhabited in later years. This city, according to the most recent opinions, is identified with Jolko, the home of Jason.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory impaired people can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	The Neolithic settlement and the Mycenaean settlement are both popular sites that can be visited.

NAME OF THE RURAL SITE:	DOMAINE ZAFEIRAKIS
GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	It is located in Tirnavos, near to the city of Larissa.
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	The Zafeirakis family has been practicing viticulture for more than 100 years. In 2005 they planted the first organic vineyard.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	The Zafeirakis Family uses biodynamic farming techniques in the vineyards of the estate. The vineyards are located in the wine-growing zone of the PGI Tirnavos is one of the most important in Greece. White Rhoditis and red Muscat Black Tirnavos have been cultivated in this location for many years. The management of the vineyard has been carefully designed aiming at minimal interference and preservation of the biodiversity of the environment.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory impaired and people in a wheelchair can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	Tyrnavos is famous for its tsipouro, ouzo and wine. The landscape around Tyrnavos has a wild beauty, with rivers, stone bridges, towers and green landscapes.

AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	The Dougos family entered the world of Greek winemaking in 1991.
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	The building is surrounded by a hectare of lush greenery and vineyards. The architecture of the building is traditional, in perfect harmony with an environment full of historical elements.  The winery is located in the Valley of Tempi, which is known since ancient times and its proximity to the mythical Mount Olympus, the home of the twelve gods, and has been a place of pilgrimage since ancient times.
ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory and visual impaired, and people with reduced visibility, or in a wheelchair, can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	It is located at the foot of mountain Olympus, in the magical Tempi valley and its environment is full of historical elements and a view of mountain Olympus, Kissavos and Pinios River.

ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory impaired people can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site. The winery has reception and tasting room on the ground floor, and organizes outdoor events on the courtyard level space
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	Patistis winery is at the southern foot of Mount Pelion, between Pagasitic Gulf and Aegean Sea and is close to many popular summer destinations and beaches.

ACCESS FOR DISABLED PEOPLE:	Auditory and visual impaired, and people with reduced visibility, or in a wheelchair, can have access to more than half of the space of the described rural site.  On the ground floor of the winery is the reception area as well as the tasting area.
CLOSER TURISTIC ATTRACTIONS:	Near the area is the artificial lake Plastira, which has a beneficial effect on the microclimate of the region, picturesque villages, places for activities and a centuries-old gastronomic tradition.

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF THE SITE:	ALONG THE RIVER PIAVE IN TREVISO PROVINCE, ZENSON DI PIAVE LITTLE TOWN	
AGE OF THE RURAL SITE:	1931	
HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC/ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OF THE SITE:	"Terre Grosse" are the clayey lands where the vineyards are located, some with plantings dating back to the 1960s. On approximately 8 hectares grow both international varieties, such as Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, and local varieties such as Glera, Manzoni Bianco 6.0.13, Verduzzo and Refosco dal Peduncolo Rosso.  The most typical varieties of the Piave area stand out	
	among all the varieties, such as Raboso and Grapariol, vines (and wines) that speak of the territory.	
	Since 1931, when the company was founded with grandfather Pietro Toninato, 4 generations have followed and since 2012 the family have undertaken a path that aims at more careful and respectful management of the environment, using the most modern knowledge and technologies. In 2018, after 3 years of conversion, they obtained organic certification: the interventions on the vineyard exclude synthetic products and are aimed at creating a natural balance as much as possible. The grass remains high to promote biodiversity, insects useful for fighting parasites are introduced and the use of modern sensors and meteorological stations allows the development of any diseases to be monitored. Only natural fertilization, combined with careful selection of the shoots, allows us to reduce the quantity of bunches on the plants, guaranteeing greater quality.	
	The family's history remains strongly rooted in this land: carrying forward this work is a way to make it relive every day with new emotions and motivations.
